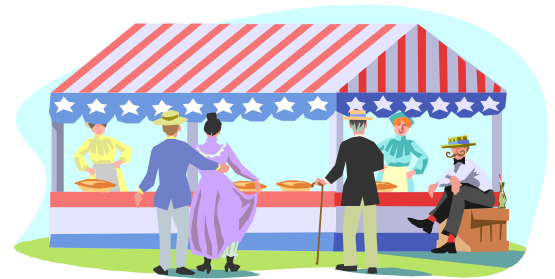
Special Note: The first 50 people to register for Clean Up Day will receive a free T-shirt. So come out and make a difference and show your community pride!
