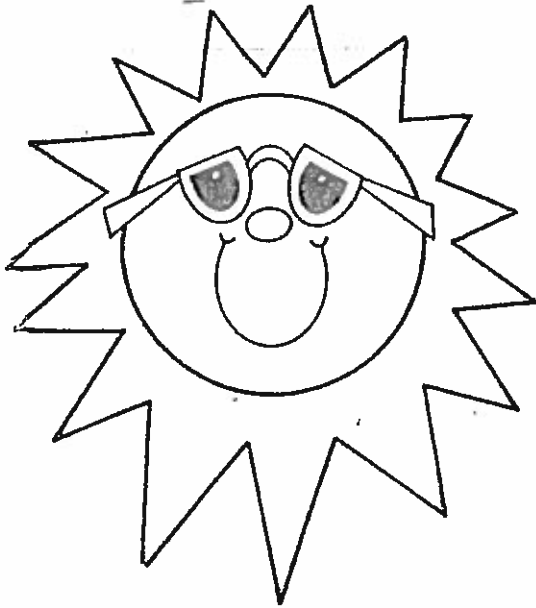


SUMMER READING
